Dear Parent/Carer/Neighbour,

RE: Redevelopment of Waseley Hills High School

I write to advise you of some future works which we will need to carry out after our normal working hours.

We are laying the concrete slabs for the ground floor over the next month, there will be more vehicle movements than usual on these days with the concrete deliveries and to ensure a smooth slab finish we will be power floating the slab once it is poured.

To manage pedestrian safety during periods of increased deliveries we have added a barriered walkway down the side of the pavement on the busiest section of the pavement up to the school, we will endeavour to keep deliveries on the school site and off of the main road when waiting to unload.

The power floating may go on into the evening dependent on the time that the concrete goes off at. The noise will be a small petrol engine working on site in the evening. We will stop working as soon as we can and leave site as quietly as possible.
