We have completed Phase 1 and the school is ready for pupils to move in in September.

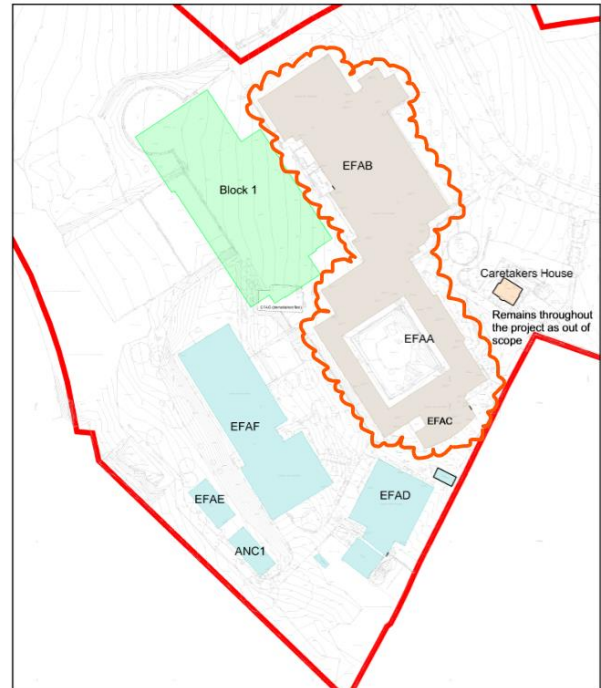


Fence lines around the site have been moved and the phase 2 demolition has been split off into the construction side with the school made safe for pupils.



We have completed surveys and demolition starts shortly with the sports hall first then working our way through the block.

This work will be undertaken with a grab and claw on a machine to strip the building carefully and dust suppression will be utilised to keep disturbance within our hoarding lines.



We will continue to plan deliveries and ensure that they come at a time which causes minimal disruption to yourselves and both of the school's.

We would like to reassure you that Tilbury Douglas are Considerate Constructors, we will always seek to complete our work in a way which causes minimal disruption and where disruption cannot be avoided we will communicate with you in advance and put in as many mitigating measures as we can.
